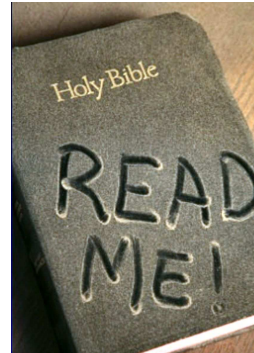
**The Farm Hands return
