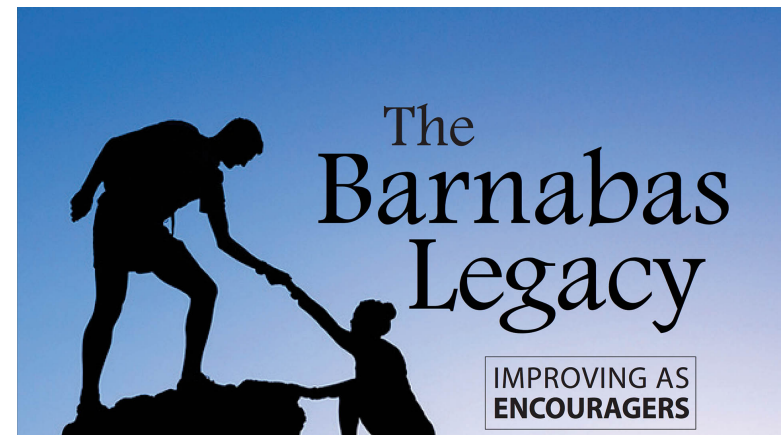

Laura attended Eastern Michigan University and studied music to become a teacher. For a brief period she taught at the East Middle School in Ypsilanti before opening her own piano studio in Pinckney.

She is the Vice President of the Michigan Music Association and a member of the American Guild of Musicians and the

Music Teachers National Association.
