Scams Targeting Seniors (and others)

Here are key ways to protect yourself or your loved one:

- Tell solicitors that you do not buy from, give to or provide information to anyone over the phone or internet! Request the information in writing.
- Take your time with decisions. Do not allow yourself to be pressured. If someone is pressuring you to “PAY UP FRONT” for services, know that this is a red flag for scammers.
- Always speak with family members before wiring money. Scammers can tell you that a family member is in need and must have money urgently sent by Western Union.
- Don’t ever provide any personal information (Medicare number, Social Security number, birth date, credit card or banking information, etc.) to unsolicited requests whether by phone, mail, or social media.
- Sign up for the “Do not Call” list (<https://www.donotcall.gov/>. OR 888 382-1222). Unknown callers are often scammers.
- Use Direct Deposit for your benefit checks to avoid having them stolen from your mailbox.
- Make a copy of all your credit cards you keep in your wallet, in case your wallet gets stolen so you can call all your accounts.

If you think you’ve been scammed, don’t be afraid or embarrassed—waiting could make it worse. Immediately:

1. Call your bank and/or credit card company.
2. Cancel any debit or credit cards linked to the stolen account.
3. Reset your personal identification numbers (PINs).
