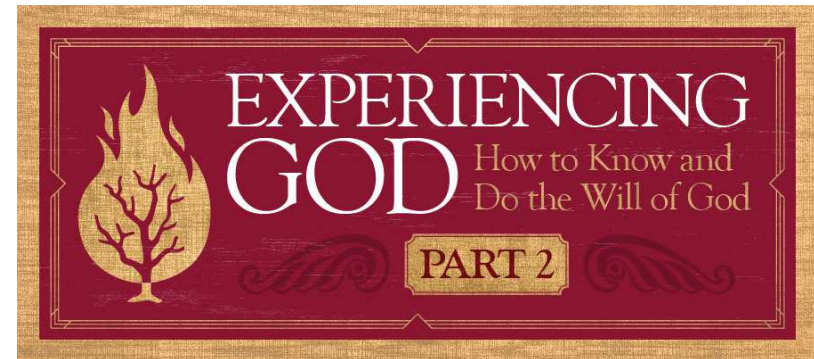

4) **PHIL and GINNY BRIER** discuss life near the lake and Phil's heroic service during WWII.

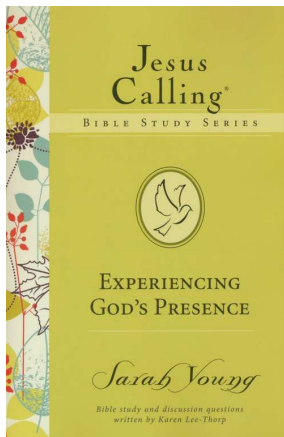
Meet at North Lake Church and you will be transported to the cemetery.
