## 2021 Christian Covenant Endowment Grants

The Christian Covenant Endowment Committee (CCEC) invites individuals and committees to submit 2021 grant applications. Grant money is now available to fund new ministries and projects that support the mission of NLUMC. A few examples of projects that got started/supported from past grants include the prayer shawl ministry; Eagle Scout projects; a Church music lending library; a remodeling project for the youth room; the Aging in Place program; and the 2019 mission trip to God's Cooperative Parish. If applicants need assistance or have questions (e.g., what kind of ministries can/cannot be funded, help writing a grant), they can contact Pastor Todd (614-270-1580) or CCEC co-chairs Joe Kummer (734-366-0268) or Ann Beyer (734 255-6844).

Application forms are available online ([northlakeumc.org](http://northlakeumc.org)), in the blue storage bin at the south entrance of the Fellowship Hall, and by contacting the Church Office (734-478-7569).

A grant application should be sent to the Church office ([northlakeumc@gmail.com](mailto:northlakeumc@gmail.com) or 14111 N. Territorial Rd., Chelsea, MI 48118), so it can be forward to the CCEC. An applicant wishing to meet with the CCEC members to discuss the application should contact Joe Kummer or Ann Beyer.

Grant applications must be submitted prior to August 31, 2021. The CCEC is usually able to notify the project leader of grant action within 30 days of the receipt of the application. Since grant funds are limited, it is advised that applications be submitted as soon as possible.
